Microchipping 4-1-1

- If my pet gets out will I be able to use this to find them?
 - The short answer is no. *This microchip does not work as a GPS.* The way your pet's microchip works is if your pet gets away from you it would have to be found and taken to a veterinary clinic or animal control to be scanned for a microchip. From there, the scanner would pick up their microchip number and after consulting a data base to determine what company your chip is with, the veterinarian or animal control officer would call 24PetWatch and get your pet's information, your contact information, and your emergency contact information to reunite your pet with you.
- Do I have to microchip my pet or pets that I am adopting?
 - This would be another no. All BRHS cats and dogs are microchipped (pending special circumstances). Microchipping is a great form of permanent identification if you happen to adopt or have a Houdini that knows how to escape a collar. Also we will point out that the fastest way a lost pet finds their way home – barring the previous sentence – is by having a well fitted collar with an identification tag!
- Can I get my non-microchipped pets not adopted from BRHS microchipped?
 - Yes!
 - \$25 + tax for animals not adopted through BRHS.
 - \$20 + tax for animals adopted from BRHS before we microchipped everyone.
 - Please call beforehand to schedule a time to have your pet microchipped.
 - Once we register the microchip with 24PetWatch for you, you have the ability to change the information that is registered on it for the rest of the lifetime of the animal OR the adoption date of the pet if you are adopting. After that time, you have a few options:
 - *Do nothing* - If your contact information and your emergency contact's information hasn't changed, you don't necessarily have to do anything. You will not be able to go in and change the information until you do one of the other options listed below. The original information registered with your pet's chip is stored and that will be the information given to authorized people inquiring about your pet's microchip number.
 - *Purchase a maintenance plan* - If you would like more options for updating your pets information we suggest giving 24PetWatch a call at the number listed at the top of the front of this page. There are many options that are available and their customer service representatives will be happy to walk you through them!
 - It is advised that you set up your microchip account as soon as possible after adoption through www.MyPetHealth.com or 1-866-597-2424.
 - This will allow you to manage your microchip subscriptions (information such as addresses and phone numbers) and report your pet as lost.
